2015 NATIONAL SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE

TO: Education Program Supervisors/ Coordinators
Public and Private Elementary and Secondary School Heads

1. Per DepEd Memorandum No. 128, s. 2015 dated November 7, 2014, this office announces that the 2015 National Schools Press Conference will be conducted on April 6 to 10, 2015 with the theme "Empowering Resilient Communities Through Campus Journalism." The host region is the National Capital Region (NCR) and the host schools division is the Division of Taguig City-Pateros, Taguig City, Metro Manila.
2. The conduct of this conference is pursuant to Republic Act (RA) No. 7079, otherwise known as the Campus Journalism Act of 1991, and in support of DepEd Order No. 47, s. 2010, entitled Guidelines on Financial Subsidy for the Conduct of the National Schools Press Conference (NSPC), its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) specifically Rule IX of Section 1.
3. The conference aims to:
 - a. demonstrate understanding of the importance of journalism by expressing it through different journalistic endeavours and approaches;
 - b. sustain advocacy on social consciousness;
 - c. provide a venue for an enriching learning experience for pupils/ students interested in pursuing journalism a career;
 - d. promote responsible journalism and fair ethical use of social media; and
 - e. enhance journalistic competence through healthy and friendly competitions.
