**1 DAY TRAINING ON VEGETABLE PRODUCTION AND GULAYAN SA PAARALAN PROGRAM

The Provincial Government of Bohol through the Office of the Provincial Agriculturist (OPA) in cooperation and partnership with partner agencies is now again conducting the annual search for the **MODELONG GULAYAN SA PAARALAN** under the **GULAYAN SA PAARALAN PROGRAM (GPP)**.
