

GUIDELINES ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SCHOOL-BASED IMMUNIZATION PROGRAM

To: All Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads  
Area Consultant  
All other Concerned

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 82, s. 2015. The Department of Education (DepEd) supports the School-Based Immunization Program of the Department of Health (DOH) as the government's response to ensure prevention of morbidity and mortality of school age children due to vaccine-preventable disease.
2. This program aims to immunize all children and adolescence enrolled in Grade 1 and 7 with DOH recommended appropriate vaccines: Measles-Rubella (MR) and Tetanus Diphtheria (TD).
3. Parental consent must be secure prior to the conduct of the vaccination. Parents in Grade 1 are also advised to bring the immunization records of their children and be present during the scheduled immunization day.
4. Attached is Regional Memorandum Nos. <sup>451</sup>453, s. 2015 together with DOH Memorandum No. 238, s. 2015- Guidelines on the Implementation of School-Based Immunization Program.
5. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum is desired.

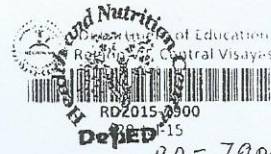


Dear **Secretary Luistro**:

In 2013 the Department of Health in collaboration with the Department of Education (DepEd) and Department of Interior and the Local Government (DILG) through various local health units successfully conducted the **First National School based Adolescent Immunization** for the newly introduced vaccines among selected public secondary schools where the high risk and vulnerability, based on behavior and potential for outbreak in school and community are observed. Due to an increasing demand of this catch-up immunization program for school children and adolescents especially among less priority areas, this year, 2015, DOH has come up with a month-long immunization campaign using Tetanus Diphtheria (Td) and Measles Rubella (MR) vaccines to all grades 1 and 7 students in public schools with a theme "Bakuna para sa Kabataan, Proteksyon sa Kinabukasan". The objective of the campaign is to continuously interrupt transmission of vaccine-preventable diseases affecting school children and to prevent poor performance due to absenteeism. The nationwide movement caught the awareness of different health partners nationwide and offered interest of support. The Charities of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints-Philippines, of Temple Drive Cor. White Plains Avenue., Greenmeadows, Quezon City, would like to donate 38,000 pieces of School-based Immunization advocacy entrance poster to be distributed to all elementary schools. In this regard, may we request for your approval as they will start putting up the posters on July 15, 2015 at designated sites of each elementary schools nationwide.
