

CONDUCT OF MID-YEAR IN-SERVICE TRAINING •

TO : Education Program Supervisors
Elementary and Secondary School Principals

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order no. 18, s. 2014, this office announces the conduct of this school year's Division School-Based Mid-year In-Service Training (INSET) on October 20 to 24, 2014.
2. The topics to be delivered within the INSET week are: Child Protection Policy, Values Education, Instructional Supervision, and Updates on Senior High School
3. This activity aims to:
 - a. enhance the teaching-learning competencies of the teachers handling Values Education,
 - b. capacitate the school heads in their function as instructional leaders, technical advisers,
 - c. stipulate the policy and guidelines on protecting children in school from abuse, violence, exploitation, discrimination, bullying and other forms of abuse.
 - d. strengthen the capabilities of the 21st century teachers,
 - e. update the K-12 curriculum especially focused on the Senior High School.
4. A copy of the Process Observation Sheet during the conduct of the INSET should be submitted to this office thru the consultants three days after the training.
5. The Regional Field Technical Assistance Team (RFTAT) together with the division supervisors will monitor and supervise the schools during the conduct of the INSET.
6. Expenses on food and materials during the training are chargeable against MOOE and other local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
