

Participants shall bring their own calculator ,pen, liquid eraser, pencil, etc. Pocket and programmable calculators are strictly prohibited. The top ten scorers shall represent Bohol to the Regional Chemistry Olympiad 2015 on February , 2015.
3. A registration fee of 100.00 shall be collected from each participant. Expenses to the said competition is **chargeable against PTA funds and other local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.** For more information please see attached communication and guidelines of the contest.

We encourage private and public schools in each area to participate in this academic competition and be given the opportunity to compete among the other delegates in Region VII.







### PROVINCIAL CHEMISTRY OLYMPIAD 2014 GUIDELINES

#### A. THE CONTESTANTS

1. All participating schools must confirm their attendance on or before November 19, 2014.
2. Each school will send three (3) students currently enrolled in the third year level of high school or lower. The coach must also be employed on the same school.
3. The participants shall fill up the registration forms an hour before the competition starts. A registration fee of PHP 100.00 per participant is required.
4. Students must be in their proper school uniform with their valid IDs on the day of the competition.

#### B. COVERAGE

1. Questions include topics from high school General Chemistry, basic Organic Chemistry (nomenclature of hydrocarbons and functional groups to be specified), and basic Biochemistry.

#### C. MECHANICS

1. Registration is from 8:00 AM until 9:00 AM at the Chemistry Lobby, 3<sup>rd</sup> floor of the Arnoldus Science Complex, USC-Talamban Campus, Nasipit, Talamban, Cebu City. Participants and coaches must register themselves during the indicated period.
2. Prior to examination, the participants must place their valuables on the area provided by the examiners.
3. Scratch papers and periodic table of elements are provided to the participants and shall be returned at the end of examination.
4. The competition consists of a 60-item written multiple choice examination. The participants shall finish answering the examination for two hours. All examination sheets and other materials provided by the organizers shall be submitted.
5. Strictly NO EXTENSION TO LATECOMERS.
6. Participants shall bring their own calculator, pen, liquid eraser, pencil, etc. Inspection shall be done prior to the start of examination. Pocket and programmable calculators are strictly prohibited.
7. Each item is worth one point.
8. Questions concerning the examination shall be addressed only to the proctor.
9. Strictly NO CHEATING and NO TALKING TO OTHER PARTICIPANTS.
10. The ten highest scoring participants shall represent the province of Cebu for the Regional Chemistry Olympiad 2015. Announcement of qualifiers shall be done an hour after the examination period.
