**DIVISION SEMINAR/ WORKSHOP ON PEDAGOGY AND APPROACHES TO DEVELOPING
LITERACY AND NUMERACY AND APPROPRIATE ASSESSMENT AND
INTERVENTION TO GRADE 1 TEACHERS**

TO: Education Program Supervisors/ Coordinators
Public and Private Elementary School Heads

1. Per Regional Memorandum No. 445, s. 2014 dated August 4, 2014; this office announces the conduct of the Division Seminar/ Workshop on Pedagogy and Approaches to Developing Literacy and Numeracy and Appropriate Assessment and Intervention to Grade 1 Teachers on November 27 – 29, 2014 at JJ's Dimsum & Restaurant, Tagbilaran City.
2. This seminar/ workshop aims to:
 - a. To develop participants knowledge and skills in the use of "Meaning and Accuracy" as an approach to developing literacy in the Mother Tongue;
 - b. To enrich participants knowledge and skills in the use of "Problem-Based Approach" in developing numeracy;
 - c. To enhance participants knowledge and skills to use appropriate teaching-learning strategies to develop the cognitive, critical thinking, and reasoning skills of pupils;
 - d. To deepen participants knowledge and skills in assessing pupils' literacy and numeracy skills and in providing appropriate intervention; and
 - e. To strengthen participants knowledge and skills in mentoring or the learning partnership program as tool for an effective and continuous professional sharing of knowledge, skills and experiences as a school-based activity via School Learning Action Cell (SLAC).
3. A registration fee of P900.00 per participant is to be collected to defray expenses for three (3) meals and six (6) snacks and some training materials like manila papers, meta cards, pentel pens, etc., to be charged against Division/ School MOOE Funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
4. Participants are required to bring with them materials to be used in the preparation of Instructional Materials/ visual aids like cartolina of different colors, pair of scissors, glue, colored papers, etc.
