

JAPANESE GOVERNEMENT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS FOR 2014

- 1 In support to the Department's thrust of improving quality education through the human resource development programs, this Office informs all teaching personnel of this division that **Japan Information and Culture Center (JICC)**, embassy of Japan is now accepting applicants for the **Teacher Training Category under the Japanese Government Scholarship Programs for 2014**. The training is a 1.5-year of study with concentrations on the following fields of study: Education Management, methods of education, special subjects, observation study, etc.
2. All Filipino citizens who meet the qualifications below are eligible to apply:
 - a. Teacher in Elementary/Secondary Level;
 - b. Five years teaching experience;
 - c. Good academic standing; and
 - d. Under 35 years old;

4. The deadline for submission of applications is on Monday, February 24, 2014, at the Japan Information and Culture Center (JICC), Embassy of Japan, 2627 Roxas Boulevard, Pasay City 1300. Only hard copies, preferably printed on A4 size paper, and mailed through courier or hand-delivered to the Embassy, will be accepted.
5. The application process consists of documentary screening, written exams, and an interview.
