CHED STUDENT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

To: Education Program Supervisors I / Division Coordinators
Public Schools District Supervisor
Heads of Public and Private Secondary Schools

1. The Commission on Higher Education (CHED) – Regional Office VII is disseminating information regarding the Student Financial Assistance Programs (STuFAPs) for Academic Year 2014-2015 which cover scholarship grant, student loan programs and other incentives available to deserving high school graduating students in both public and private institutions.
2. The General Requirements for the Scholarship Programs are as follows:
 - a. Must be a Filipino citizen of good moral character;
 - b. Must not be more than 30 years of age at the time of application except for senior citizens;
 - c. Must be a high school graduate or a candidate for graduation;
 - d. Must have a combined annual gross income of parents/guardian not to exceed Three Hundred Thousand Pesos (P 300,000.00). For those who are exempted from filing income tax, there should be a certificate of tax exemption from the BIR. For OCW and Seafarers, a latest copy of contract or proof of income;
 - e. Must not be a recipient of any government scholarship and financial assistance.
3. The Documentary Requirements are as follows:
 - a. Accomplished CHED STuFAPs Application (OSS Form 01);
 - b. Duly certified High School Report Card for third year and grades for the first three grading periods for fourth year;
 - c. Latest Income Tax Return (ITR), Certificate of Tax Exemption or Copy of Contract or proof of income of parents/guardian from Bureau of Internal Revenue;
 - d. Certificate of good moral character from the high school principal/guidance counselor.
4. Application Form and the list of CHED priority courses are enclosed in this memorandum. The application should be sent to:
