INTER-CITY HIGH SCHOOL QUIZ BOWL

1. The College of Engineering and Computer Studies of Holy Name University will be hosting its annual **13th HNU Engineering & IT Fair and Project Exhibit** on March 9-11, 2017 at the Atrium of BQ Mall this city.
2. One of the highlights of the said activity is the **Inter-City High School Quiz Bowl** which is scheduled on the second day of the exhibit, **March 10 (Friday) at 9:00 AM**. The quiz bowl will be composed of three categories namely: Science, Mathematics and Computer.
3. Each participating school must send three participants, one for every category. Participants must be bonafide students of any public or private secondary school and may belong from different grade levels. They must wear their school uniform during the competition in order for their school to be recognized.
4. The participating schools must fill-in a registration form which can be secured at the Dean's Office of the College of Engineering and Computer Studies located at the 2nd floor of Bates building, Holy Name University, Janssen Heights, Dampas, Tagbilaran City. The form must be submitted on or before February 24, 2017 at 11:00 AM.

Contest Mechanics

1. Each participant will answer the same set of questions in writing. Each participant will be provided with markers, answer boards, and erasers.
2. Questions will be read twice by the quizmaster. After the second reading, the quizmaster shall ring the bell and automatically the ten (10) seconds time limit will begin. If a question requires enumeration or needs computation, the time limit will be extended to five (5) more seconds.
3. After the allotted time and the bell rings, the participant should stop writing and raise their answer boards. If the participant violates this rules his/her answer shall be considered void.
4. The contest has (3) three rounds, **EASY** round, **AVERAGE** round, and **DIFFICULT** round. In Easy round, fifteen (15) questions will be asked. Each question will worth one (1) point. The Average round has ten (10) questions with corresponding three (3) points for every correct answer. Finally, in the difficult round, ten (10) questions will be asked with five (5) points worth for every correct answer. For all problem solving questions, it is worth double to the intended points for that round.
5. The participant with the accumulated highest scores will be declared as the 1st placer, 2nd placer, and 3rd placer. Should there be a tie, extra three (3) questions (Easy, Average, Difficult) with corresponding points (as stated in item 4) will be asked by the quizmaster in order to break the tie.
6. The duly registered coach of the participant is the only person authorized to make a protest. All protest should be referred to the Chairman of the quiz bowl immediately, and be entertained only before the quizmaster reads the next question.
7. An over-all champion will be announced after the three categories. Points will be given to the winners of each category. Five (5) points will be given to the 1st placer, three (3) points to the 2nd placer, and two (2) points for the 3rd placer. The team with the highest points will be declared as Champion, 1st runner-up, and 2nd runner-up.
