In view of the recent natural disasters that caused major devastation and loss of human lives and damage to properties, we believe there is an urgent need to confront the issue of climate change and decisively address its adverse effects on the people and on the production sectors. Consequently, Republic Act 9729, also known as the "Climate Change Act of 2009", mandates all Local Government Units (LGUs) to formulate, plan and implement Climate Change Action Plans in their respective areas, consistent with the provisions of the Local Government Code, the National Framework Strategy on Climate Change, and the National Climate Change Action Plan. This Act also mandates all LGUs to mobilize and allocate necessary personnel, resources and logistics to effectively implement their respective action plans.

The City Government of Tagbilaran, through the Climate Change Committee recently created to promote a broader multi-stakeholder participation and integrate climate change mitigation and adaptation and to act and resolve with urgency in addressing the issues of climate change, is coordinating with the Association of United Development and Information Officers (AUDIO) – Bohol, a non-profit organization of information officers from the local government units and national government agencies in the province of Bohol, to conduct the FORUM ON ENVIRONMENT, CLIMATE CHANGE, AND DISASTER MANAGEMENT scheduled on **FEBRUARY 16, 2017 (THURSDAY), from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon at the DR. 
