TO : All Area/District Chairmen, District Commissioners, Deputy District Commissioners, Members of the Council Training Team, DFCs, Public/Private School Principals/Heads and all concerned.

SUBJECT : EMERGENCY SERVICE TRAINING COURSE

1. The Bohol Council, Boy Scouts of the Philippines, DepEd Bohol Division and DepEd Tagbilaran City Division in coordination with TaRSIER 117 (Telephone and Radio Integrated Emergency Response) of the Provincial Government of Bohol will conduct the Emergency Service Training Course on April 20-23, 2016 at Roxas Park, Calma, Garcia-Hernandez, Bohol.
2. The training will be conducted with the following objectives:
 - 1) Produce more emergency responders in the province coming from the scouts & scouters.
 - 2) Make the council a support agency/unit to the TaRSIER 117 in times of emergencies.
 - 3) Assist aspiring scouts with their advancement requirements on emergency preparedness.
3. Qualified participants will be currently registered members of the Council Training Team who are physically and medically fit as certified by a physician.
4. A training fee of One Thousand Six Hundred Pesos (₱ 1,600.00) shall be charged to each participant to cover the expenses for meals & snacks, supplies, and other administrative expenses. Transportation to the venue from the point of origin and vise-versa and other incidental expenses incurred outside the course will be shouldered by the participant.
5. Participating scouters shall be entitled to service credits in accordance with existing guidelines.
6. Participants are requested to report promptly at the venue on April 20, 2016 at 7:00 o'clock in the morning for registration bringing the following items:
 - Type A uniform (long pants)
 - reference materials which you may consider useful
 - accomplished medical certificate
 - black shoes with shoelace (low cut, leather)
 - dome tent and sleeping bags, ground cloth
 - activity short/sports wear, pajamas, slippers, rubber shoes
 - casual clothing/personal accessories
 - mess kit, first aid kit, toilet articles
 - swimming attire, jacket, raincoat/poncho
