The training is designed to impart knowledge on updates in policies, laws, strategies and programs of the government with regards to Anti-illegal Drugs Campaign.


We are inviting ten (10) participants from the Department of Education-Tagbilaran City Division to this Trainer's Training.

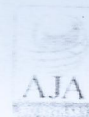
