SUBJECT : 2017 Public Sector HR Symposium

The Civil Service Commission (CSC) is organizing the **2017 Public Sector HR Symposium** with the theme, **"Shaping Change."** The event will be held on July 4 - 6, 2017 in Pasay City.

This year's HR Symposium highlights concepts, perspectives and insights in managing change brought about by new directions and management approaches. It also showcases practices and experiences of progressive organizations in introducing, coping and shaping change. Furthermore, it emphasizes the need to shape changes in various levels.

The ASEAN Community is an example of a changing organization. As it celebrates its 50th year, it is undergoing significant changes particularly with respect to the integration of its member states. The Philippines, as its current Chair, has chosen the theme "Partnering for Change, Engaging the World" to represent ASEAN's advocacy to bring positive change in the region and its neighbors.

Leaders, Human Resource Management Officers (HRMOs) and other executives and practitioners from both the public and private sectors are encouraged to participate in the event.
