The National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA), through the National Music Competitions for Young Artists (NAMCYA) and the Musicological Society of the Philippines (MSP), will conduct the **First Rondalla Music Camp** from July 8 to 23, 2017 in Baguio City, Benguet. The Music Camp will focus on enhancing the proficiency of rondalla practitioners.

3. Topics and lessons include Music Theory, Music Analysis, Music History, Writing for Rondalla, Conducting and Playing Techniques of banduria, octavina, laud, mandola, guitar, bass and percussion instruments.
