5. School Heads and School Sports Coordinators are directed to submit the names of their selected/chosen four (4) players with a photocopy of their birth certificate and duly signed parents consent and letter of recommendation from the School Head.
6. Deadline of submission of the aforementioned papers and list is on June 20, 2017 at the Division Office thru: Mr. Alberto A. Lacang, EPS-1 MAPEH.
7. In this connection, a meeting of all selected/chosen Elementary and Secondary basketball players is set on June 27, 2017 at 3:00 pm, Division Conference Hall.

Dear Supt. Zapanta,

A free basketball clinic was started by the Corales family of Tagbilaran City last year to commemorate the first death anniversary of the family's patriarch, Mar, who died on May 1, 2015. Around 100 children of poor and less fortunate families in Tagbilaran City availed of the clinic under the tutelage of competent basketball coaches led by Mr. Peter Naron, a retired PBA player.

This project is intended to help children who are interested to improve their playing skills through a formal training without paying anything which the free clinic can provide in order to make them competitive if they aspire to get a scholarship in order to advance their education. Last year's clinic proved helpful in honing the playing skills of the kids as shown in the friendly competition on the last day of the clinic. The Corales family, therefore, has decided to continue with the same clinic this year every weekend throughout the whole month of July. This is an opportunity for the kids who otherwise may not be able to undergo the same clinic if it were not free since it could cost the family a lot of money. With enough training, they could easily obtain a scholarship that will provide them a degree in order to pull them and their families out of poverty. Mar Corales earned a law degree from Divine Word College (now Holy Name University) by being a basketball scholar.

You can get somebody to earn a degree. Help me find deserving students from each of your schools to get a good training in basketball. The undersigned, who is the widow of the late Mar Corales and is the principal convenor of the basketball clinic, is asking you to help by sending us deserving students aged 8 to 15 to the clinic which will be held starting Saturday, July 1, 2017 at the Bohol Institute of Technology (BIT) gym along Gallares St., here in Tagbilaran City. I would like to visit the kids together with a few members of the committee at their convenience starting Tuesday, June 13.. Please advise by using any of the telephone numbers above.

Please accept my sincere thanks for your cooperation. Your move in this regard will certainly make a huge difference in the children's and their family's lives.,
