IMPLEMENTATION OF THE DIVISION INITIATED EPP/TLE/TVL RELATED PROJECTS

To: **ASDS, CHIEFS. EPS
PUBLIC SCHOOL HEADS (ELEM & SEC)
CONCERNED PERSONNEL**

1. This Office is reminding all schools to sustain implementation of the following Division initiated EPP/TLE/TVL projects:

a. Edible Landscaping Competition

The Board of Judges will conduct the evaluation in three schedules:

1st Evaluation = August – September 2017

2nd Evaluation = November – December 2017

3rd Evaluation = February – March 2018

In determining the winners, the points from the 1st to 3rd Evaluation will be added and divided by three.

b. School Nursery

In ensuring the sustainability of the garden, every school must have a functional nursery. It is included in the criteria for judging the Edible Landscaping Competition.

c. Vermi Composting

In growing our vegetable, vermi compost is used. To attain this, each school is encouraged to have a vermi composting project. Please notify this Office if you need vermi worms immediately for coordination with the Office of the Provincial Agriculturist.

d. Gulayan Sa Tahanan

Believing in the importance and the impact of this project, school heads are directed to closely monitor the implementation of this project by parents at home. It is suggested that a committee composed of parents in every homeroom organization be organized to help in the monitoring of this project.

e. Gulayan sa Paaralan

Since the edible landscaping requires only 50 square meter land area, other vacant spaces in the school campus suitable for planting vegetable should be utilized for the Gulayan Sa Paaralan program.

f. Mushrooms

Those teachers who were trained in Mushroom are encouraged to implement this project in their school. Personnel from the Agricultural Promotion Center (APC) are very much willing to give technical assistance to our schools.

g. Native Chicken Dispersal

Those schools which have availed of the native chicken dispersal from the Office of the Provincial Veterinarian should maintain this project and allow it to grow in number.

h. Agricultural Training Institute (ATI) Adopt A School Project

ATI adopted schools must sustain the projects implemented in your schools. Concerned School Heads must submit to this Office and to the ATI the status of the implementation and the audited report from the ATI not later than July 21, 2017. ATI is very much willing to assist you for the sustainability of these projects.

2. A complete documentation both photos (before, during and after) and narrative of the above mentioned projects is directed be submitted to this Office and copy furnish to Mr. Joseph C. Barrete, TLE supervisor for filing.

3. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum is desired.
