

GUIDELINES FOR THE HIT THE POT CONTEST

(in lieu of PALO SEBO)

STUDENT CATEGORY:

1. Only one (1) contestant from every participating schools during the contest;
2. Contestant must be a bonafide High School student;
3. Shall present school Identification Card (ID) for the school year before the contest start;
4. Physically and mentally fit for the contest;
5. Contestant shall receive P2,000 as winner and no consolation prize for non-winner;
6. First student to arrived and register at the venue shall perform first and to be followed accordingly;
7. The decisions of the judges are final.

FARMER CATEGORY:

1. Contestant shall not a government employee to any Local Government Units;
2. Only one (1) contestant for every participating Municipal/City Local Government Units;
3. Shall be endorsed by the Municipal/City Agricultural Officers;
4. Physically and mentally fit for the contest;
5. Contestant shall receive P2,000 as winner and no consolation prize for non-winner;
6. First farmer to arrived and register at the venue shall perform first and to be followed accordingly;
7. The decisions of the judges are final.

STUDENT CATEGORY:

1. Only (1) contestant for every participating schools during the contest.
2. Contestant must be a bonafide High School male student.
3. Can present student school ID for the school year.
4. Physically and mentally fit for the contest.
5. Contestant who can catch the piglets and can present to the Judges will be declared winners.
6. Caught piglets will serve as prizes to the winning contestant.

FARMER CATEGORY:

1. Only (1) contestant for every participating Municipal Local Government Units.
2. Contestant must be a bonafide male farmer endorsed by the Municipal Agriculturist/
Municipal Agricultural Officers.
3. Physically and mentally fit for the contest.
4. Contestant who can catch the piglets and can present to the Judges will be declared winners.
5. Caught piglets will serve as prizes to the winning contestant.
