STARBOOKS KIOSK DESIGN

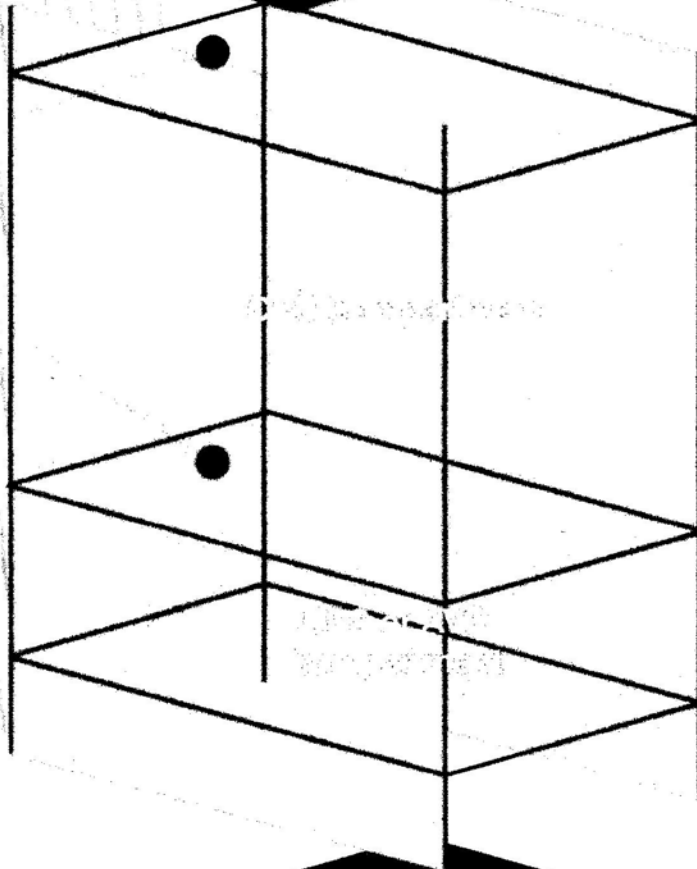
