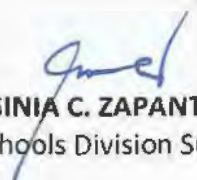

GUKOD SA OKTUBRE

Like other youth organizations, Red Cross Youth uses team building activities as “skill and value formation” to its youth members. Nevertheless, RCY has a different strategy or style on giving challenges during team-building activities so-called “The Red Cross Way”. During RCY trainings and social gatherings, the teambuilding activity is the most-awaited part, given that it’s unique not only on the challenges themselves but also on the relevance of values and skill development in line with the works and efforts of the premiere humanitarian organization. On RCY Summercamps, Team-building outdoor activity is commonly known as “The Amazing Solferino Race”, depicting the “The Battle of Solferino” that happened at Solferino, Italy on the year 1859 wherein the idea of the Red Cross was born.

This Bohol Red Cross Youth Days 2016, Red Cross Youth Bohol will hold the grandest and biggest event of challenges to our youth volunteers: “**Gukod sa Oktubre**” or “Race on October” (since activities like this only happen during gatherings that usually fall on summers). This will be a 2-day activity open to all RCY Volunteers from different Senior, College, and Community RCY Councils. The outdoor activity also includes “mini-games” open to the youth, advocacy booths on Leadership, Pledge25 Youth Blood Donation, HAPE/SAPE, First Aid, other health promotions, and Membership Fund Drive. The main event, **Ang Gukod**, still stands out.

- The race is open to all RCY Councils in the province of Bohol.
- Interested councils must submit the registration form given by the organizing team and must be passed on or before October 14, 2016 – Friday, at the Philippine Red Cross Bohol Chapter, Red Cross Youth Office or email us at redcrossyouthbohol@gmail.com
- The council can send at most (2) entries composed of 6 members per entry. *Note: An entry shall consist at least 40% of RCY Volunteers*
- The participating volunteers must be physically fit to join the race that will cover the entire City of Tagbilaran.
- The Race is divided into two parts: (1) **WE DARE**, where all registered councils will compete for the winning slots. The Top 3 Council Finishers of We Dare will pave the way to (2) **THE REAL CHALLENGE**, where the 3 groups will compete for the 1st Place.
- The race will be on October 25-26, 2016, Monday-Tuesday.
- The racers must arrive at the venue 30 minutes before the start of the race. Failure to do so will mean automatic disqualification.
- The number of stations and procedure of challenges will be announced on the day of the race

The activities and gatherings initiated by the Chapter Youth Council these past few years were mostly for Senior, College, and Community RCY Councils only. However, this year 2016, Junior Red Cross is one of the components with growing number of volunteers in the province.

As one of the goals of **Bohol Red Cross Youth Days 2016** which intends to gather all volunteers in one event as one family to promote solidarity; we give opportunity to our Junior Red Cross Volunteers to be part of the RCY Month Celebration. The Search aspires to build a united and empowered Red Cross Youth through positive interactions, building new relationships, motivating personal growth, and encouragement. Participating in the Search for Ms. Red Cross Youth Bohol not only provides a woman youth volunteer an opportunity to gain additional life experiences, but also to bring awareness to important humanitarian issues in the Philippines especially in Bohol. Contestants can enhance their personal and professional skills while developing their performance-related talents.

The Search for Ms. Red Cross Youth Bohol is more than a mere beauty and brain contest for the youth; it is a pageant that ponders all aspects of their appearances and characters. Its mission is to crown beautiful youth volunteers with love, passion, and advocacy for humanity. The top five (5) contestants have the opportunity to be youth representatives of the different objectives of the youth organization. The crowned winner will represent and advocate for Red Cross Youth Bohol. She will be entitled as Bohol Red Cross Youth Ambassadors during her reign. Finalists will also have chances to participate in various events, work with various humanitarian causes and make lifetime memories.





Pageant Guidelines and Mechanics:

A. Qualifications

Senior, College, and Community Red Cross Youth Councils in Bohol are encouraged to endorse one (1) female candidate per council for **Miss Red Cross Youth Bohol 2016** title. She:

- must be a bona fide Red Cross Youth Volunteer of a School Council in Bohol;
- must be legally single without children;
- must be at least 17 years old and not be more than 25 years old this year;
- must submit a signed parents'/guardian's waiver if she is 17 years old;
- must have never won any major title in any municipal, city-wide, provincial, regional, national, or international beauty pageants;
- will have to secure a written endorsement from her respective RCY Adviser and School Head;
- must be able to attend all scheduled activities and rehearsals
- must avail the P60.00 Classic Membership if still not a member of PRC.

Note: The Presidents of the RCY Councils are not qualified to join. They have separate responsibilities as per order by the Council of Presidents and Chapter Youth Council.

B. Pageant Mechanics

Candidates will be required to prepare for and participate in the following parts of the pageant:

PART 1 (Pre-pageant)

1. Panel Interview

- Candidates will be interviewed by a panel composed of three (3) interviewers within ten minutes.
- Required Attire: Casual wear, Red Cross Youth School/Community Council Uniform
- Date and Place of Interview will be announced upon submission of endorsement.

2. Photo-shoot

- Candidates must free their schedule half-a-day for the Photo-shoot.
- Required Attire: Red Cross Youth Type B Uniform.
- Date, time, and place of Photo-shoot will be announced upon submission of endorsement
- Photographer's choice of candidate will receive the Miss Photogenic Award. (Set of Criteria will be given to the photographer as guide)

2. Support Boxes

- The RCY councils of the candidates will be given Support Boxes after the photo-shoot; one (1) per council.
- Support boxes are coin banks with pictures of the candidates. Everyone can give one vote to their candidate by donating one (1) peso in her support box.
- The boxes are to be surrendered to the authorized officers 1 hour before the pageant proper.
- The counting of money will be documented and must be witnessed by one (1) representative from the Chapter Youth Council.





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one (1) representative from the Council of Presidents, and one (1) representative from the League of Advisers.

- The Candidate with the most no. of votes will become part of the Top 5 Finalists. *(if the candidate with the most no. of votes is already part of the Top 3, the second with the most no. of votes can have the chance)*

3. Social People's Choice

- After the photo-shoot, the photos of the candidates will be uploaded on the Official Facebook Account of Red Cross Youth Bohol (fb.com/RCYBohol).
- Everyone can give one vote to their candidate by reacting **WOW** in her official pageant photo.
- The voting will close 12 hours before the pageant proper.
- The checking of votes will be documented and must be witnessed by one (1) representative from the Chapter Youth Council, one (1) representative from the Council of Presidents, and one (1) representative from the League of Advisers.
- The Candidate with the most wow reactions will become part of the Top 5 Finalists. *(if the candidate with the most wow reactions is already part of the Top 3, the second with the most wow reactions can have the chance)*

PART 2(Pageant)

1. Production Number

- The attire will be finalized during the rehearsals.

2. Talent Portion

- Performance must be within two (2) minutes only. Timer starts with the first sound, or action in the talent. A timer will signal the end of the time duration. If candidate extends her performance 5 seconds or more after the signal, 3 points will be deducted from the average score.
- Back-up performers are allowed if and only they're 15 years old and above. *(Performers below 18 years old will give a waiver signed by parents as implementation of the Child Protection Policy of the Philippine Red Cross.)*
- Praps and supporting accompaniments may be used as long as they are provided by the RCY Council. The Set-up and Set-down of stuffs must be within one (1) minute each. 0.10 points of the candidate will be deducted for every second extension of set-up.
- Fire, Water, Weapons and other dangerous, harmful, and explicitly offending objects, and even confetti are not allowed to be used as props.
- Talent performances must value the Principles of the Red Cross Movement. It means that it must be within the limit of moral decency and must not offend anyone's sensibilities.

3. Boholana Filipiniana Wear

- In RCY Bohol, formal wears go beyond expectations. The candidate will present her artistic piece of Filipiniana Wear created originally by the volunteers using recyclable and eco-friendly materials. The said creation must reflect with the motif: **"Boholano Culture"**
- This is the chance to prove the creativity of RCY Volunteers in a council.
- Make sure that the candidate can still move and walk comfortably with her outfit.



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Part 3(Pogeont- Finol Round)

1. Question and Answer Portion

- List of possible question will be shown to the condidates the day before the pogeont
- The list of questions is exclusively for the candidates only. They are not allowed to take pictures on it.
- On the pageont proper, one common question will be thrown by the judges. They will just repeat the question twice per candidate.
- A judge can give one (1) follow-up question for emphasis and clorification and it must be in line with the main question.

C. Criteria for Judging

Scoring will simply be with an over-all score from 1 to 10, with increments of one decimal digit (0.1). The rating shall be based on the general impression of the judge according to the following criterio:
