1. In line with DepEd Order No. 83, s. 2012 entitled Implementing Guidelines on the Revised School-Based Management (SBM) Framework, Assessment Process and Tools (APAT), the Department of Education continues to build networks of educational leaders to schools and communities that will guide the educational system achieve its shared vision, mission, and goals. To further sustain this policy direction, the DepEd shall strengthen the cooperation, collaboration and partnership among schools believing that schools which are high performing can be valuable partners in terms of resources, coaching, mentoring as role models for those schools that have not yet reached their level of potentials.
2. To provide a mechanism and guidance for this kind of cooperation and culture of sharing, DepEd central office issued DepEd Order No. 44 dated June 22, 2016 entitled "**Guidelines on the School-to-School Partnership for Fiscal Year 2016**". Fund allocation with a Sub-Allotment Release Order was already received by this office amounting to 420,000.00 for the purpose.
3. It is in this light that a coordination meeting and a contract of agreement between leader school and partner schools shall be conducted on **November 8, 2016** to discuss further the guidelines of the said project and agree some provisions of support and commitment. This will be conducted at the **Division Conference Room at 9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.**
4. Participants to this coordination meeting are school principals of the above-mentioned Leader and Partner Schools and their corresponding School SBM Coordinators or its equivalent.
5. No registration fee shall be collected. Participants are expected to bring their own copy of the DepEd Order No. 44. For further details of the said activity you may contact Liza Maquiling, Division SBM Focal Person.
