
**2017 COUNCIL SCOUT YOUTH FORUM**

**SUBJECT :** **2017 COUNCIL SCOUT YOUTH FORUM**

1. The Bohol Council, Boy Scouts of the Philippines is announcing the conduct of 2017 Council Youth Forum on September 29 - October 1, 2017 at the BSP Headquarters, Tagbilaran City.
2. This will be conducted to give opportunity to potential scouts to develop their capabilities in parliamentary procedures and express their ideas on the current issues of the country. This is also for them to elect their representative to the Council Executive Board for the 2018 and to the National Scout Youth Forum.
3. All districts except for Tagbilaran City Division and Private Institutions are encouraged to send the maximum of three (3) of their most qualified scouts either from the elementary or secondary who must be duly registered, ages 11-17 years old, with good scholastic record and can speak English and Filipino fluently.
4. A registration fee of Eight Hundred Fifty Pesos (P 850.00) per participant will be collected for the cost of meals/snacks, forum materials and documentation expenses. Registration, transportation and other related expenses of participants will be chargeable to the MOOE, School/District Scouting Funds or to any other available local school funds.
5. Participants must bring the following:
  - a. Complete Type A and B uniforms
  - b. Extra clothing
  - c. Notebook and ball pen
  - d. Mess Kit (spoon, fork, plate & cup)
  - e. Beddings and toiletries
6. Participating scouts must report at the venue at 5:30 in the afternoon of September 29, 2017 for registration, billeting and opening program.
