The ASEAN Training for Prevention Drug Education (ATCPDE) based in the University of the Philippines (UP) College of Education will conduct the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) Conference on Drug Prevention International Standards from December 5 to 7, 2016 at the National Institute for Science and Mathematics Education Development (NISMED) Auditorium, UP, Diliman, Quezon City. This is a live-out Conference.

The Conference aims to:

1. disseminate to the participants the crucial themes of the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC) International Standards on Drug Use Prevention; and
