**39<sup>TH</sup> NATIONAL ENCAMPMENT OF THE GIRL SCOUTS OF THE PHILIPPINES**

1. The Girl Scouts of the Philippines (GSP) will hold its **39<sup>th</sup> National Encampment** with the theme *Pamaskong Handog sa Inang Kalikasan* (Christmas Gifts for Mother Earth) from December 1 to 6, 2016 at the Josefa Llanes Escoda National Program and Training Center, Palayan City, Nueva Ecija. This will be hosted by the GSP Central Luzon Region.
2. The Encampment aims to:
  - a. enable the participants to stimulate real enjoyment and appreciation of the outdoors through progressive camping experiences;
  - b. allow them to express their appreciation for outdoor living, and concern for the environment;
  - c. develop their resourcefulness, initiative and self-reliance;
  - d. provide them with new and interesting experiences with the opportunity to acquire new skills;
  - e. develop their physical and mental well-being; and
  - f. let them demonstrate cooperation, teamwork, friendship and fun among their co-participants.
3. The campers will experience exciting and adventure-filled activities which will take place not only in the campsite but also at the Fort Magsaysay.
4. In view of this, each of the 97 GSP Councils is encouraged to send eight senior girl scouts (high school) and one troop leader who will serve as the chaperone of the girls scouts, and participate in the National Troop Leaders Forum on the same dates.
5. All participating girl scouts and troop leaders, as well as those who will serve as camp staff are allowed to attend this event.
