




1. The Teachers' Dignity Coalition (TDC) will conduct its **National Seminar on Department of Education (DepEd) Policies and Legal Process** with the theme *Teachers' Empowerment Through Legal Education* from March 3 to 5, 2017 at the Angela's Pool Resort, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan.
2. The Seminar aims to educate the teacher-leaders on their rights and responsibilities and their contribution to strengthen the DepEd legal process. It specifically aims to:
 - a. equip the teacher-leaders and school heads (SHs) with legal knowledge;
 - b. assist them in resolving conflicts arising from school management;
 - c. provide them with information on pertinent issues of education sector; and
 - d. solicit suggestions to improve the teaching conditions of the teachers.
3. The target participants are faculty club presidents, guidance counselors or teachers, and SHs of public elementary and secondary schools nationwide. Selected members of the TDC National Council shall serve as members of the secretariat. The TDC Secretariat will coordinate with the regional offices regarding the list of participants. Participants and members of the TDC National Council shall attend **on official time only**.
4. The participants' registration and transportation expenses shall be charged to personal funds. A registration fee of Three Thousand Pesos (P 3,000.00) shall be charged to each participant. Registration and billeting will start at 1:00 p.m. on March 3, 2017 (Day 1), and check-out time will be at 12:00 noon on March 5, 2017 (Day 3). Those interested to attend are advised to confirm their participation **on or before January 6, 2017**.
