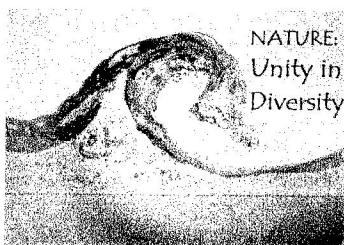

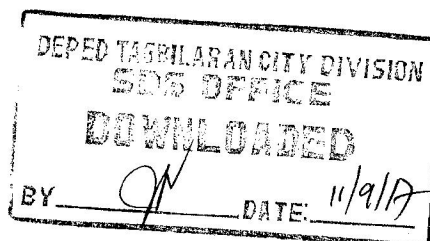

RATIONALE:

The Environmental Management Bureau Region 7 has chosen some 10 schools of Tagbilaran City Division-DepEd 7 to be the first pilot schools for the National Ecosavers Program (NEP) implementation in Central Visayas. Funding assistance shall be extended to the partner Local Government Unit, Tagbilaran City, and to the selected schools for the first 10 months of the project. NEP aims to develop, implement and install the sustainability mechanisms of the Ecosavers Program which is a strategic approach to Ecological Solid Waste Management in public elementary schools and high schools. It is intended to lengthen the life of Alburquerque Sanitary Landfill and establish Tagbilaran City as the pilot LGU for the implementation of the new waste management systems that shall be introduced through a training-workshop this November.

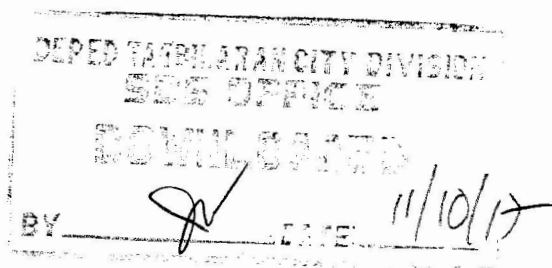
