CONTINUING EDUCATION FOR MUSIC TEACHERS OF THE UNIVERSITY
OF THE PHILIPPINES COLLEGE OF MUSIC

The University of the Philippines (UP) College of Music will conduct a post-baccalaureate certificate program for music teachers: Continuing Education for Music Teachers (CEMT).

The program aims to:

1. equip the teacher-participants with a thorough understanding of the principles of music theory, practice, and pedagogy;
2. enable them to apply musical and pedagogical knowledge and skills in solo and group rehearsal, performance, and in general music classroom experiences; and
3. increase their appreciation of varied music teaching and learning situations, as well as of diverse forms of music-making and music cultures in the Philippines and the world.

The following are the important dates to be taken note of:

Enrollment	April 2, 2018
Opening of Classes	April 16, 2018
Culminating Activity	May 12, 2018

The target participants are teachers from both public and private schools.

The program is composed of 68 units spread out in three levels over three summers. A certificate of program completion will be given by the UP College of Music Extension Program at the end of the program to participants who have completed the three levels of training.
