DIVISION TRAINING OF KINDERGARTEN TEACHERS ON KINDERGARTEN PEDAGOGIES, CHILD-CENTERED APPROACHES, DAP-ELLN, AND CLASSROOM-BASED ASSESSMENT

1. Per Regional Memorandum No. 0290, s. 2018 dated April 19, 2018, this Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will conduct a **“Division Training of Kindergarten Teachers on Kindergarten Pedagogies, Child-Centered Approaches, DAP-ELLN, and Classroom-Based Assessment”** on **May 30 to June 1, 2018** at the **Reyna’s Haven Garden and Restaurant, Tagbilaran City.**
2. The objectives of this training include the following:
 - a. develop understanding on the principles of early childhood education and pedagogical skills in teaching Mother Tongue and the bridging process in learning other languages;
 - b. provide updates on the content of the Kindergarten program; and
 - c. capacitate teachers with relevant approaches in teaching kindergarten, contextualizing kindergarten activities, and assessing Early Literacy and Materials Development in MTB.
3. Participants to this training are all Grade 1 teachers in the public schools. A **registration fee of P 900.00 per participant** is to be collected to defray expenses for the meals and snacks of the participants and trainers for the duration of three (3) days to be charged against Local/School/ Division MOOE funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
4. Teacher-participants for this training are entitled to service credits in accordance with the provisions of DepEd Order No. 19, s. 2011 and DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003.
5. All participants are advised to bring the following materials such as the **Kindergarten Teachers Guide, Kindergarten Curriculum Guide and Art Materials.**
