**CONSULTATION - WORKSHOP ON THE NEW SBM  
NATIONAL FRAMEWORK AND ASSESSMENT RUBRICS**

1. After our Division SBM Re-orientation on the Framework, Assessment Process and Tools (SBM-APAT) last June 28, 2017, this SBM APAT was rescinded after the DepEd-CO School Effectiveness Division, Bureau of Human Resource and Organizational Development (BHROD) released a new SBM Assessment rubrics aligned to the RPMS. The revised rubrics has descriptors for the enabling factors and standard rubrics for each enabling factors and raises the former 3 levels of practice from developing, maturing and advance to 4 levels namely: Beginning, Proficient, Highly Proficient and Distinguished.
2. It is in this light that a one-day consultation-workshop on the new SBM assessment level and rubrics will be held on **July 5, 2018, at 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M., BODARE Multi-Purpose Center, J.A. Clarin Street, Tagbilaran City.**
3. The objective of this one-day consultation-workshop is to review the new assessment levels of practice its descriptors, standards and rubrics for each enabling factors. This will be through a unified understanding and identification of the following:
  - a) Motivating factors (monetary and non-monetary) in each enabling factors;
  - b) Areas where learners can participate;
  - c) Means of verification; and
  - d) Support needed by the school.
4. Participants to this activity are the following: Education Program Supervisors, Public School District Supervisor, Division Coordinators, Senior Education Specialist, Education Specialist, Planning Officers, Program Development Officer, Dentists, Nurses, Public School Elementary and Secondary Principals and Assistant Principals, Head Teachers and School SBM Coordinators/Focal Persons.
5. Expenses relative to and in the conduct of the School Level SBM Assessment Orientation shall be charge to Division and School MOOE funds subject to the usual auditing rules and regulations.
