SUBJECT : PATROL/CREW LEADERS TRAINING COURSES

1. Announcing the **schedules** for the 2018 Patrol/Crew Leaders Training courses, to wit:
August 3-5, 2018 - Pres. Carlos P. Garcia Central Elementary School for CPG District and other districts who wish to join.
August 17-19, 2018 - Tubigon West National High School for CD I
- Tapal Integrated School, Ubay for CD II
August 24-26, 2018 - Pamacsalan Elementary School for Pilar district and other districts who wish to join.

~~August 31-September 2, 2018 - Carmen East Central ES for CD III~~


2. These training courses **aim to contribute in the formation of our young boys into responsible leaders of our society in the future.**
3. A training fee of **Three Hundred (300.00) Pesos** will be charged to each participant to defray the expenses for **manuals, certificates and training materials** chargeable to the MOOE or to any available local school funds including transportation to and from the venue and other related expenses.
4. Food provision throughout the duration of the training will be the responsibility of the participants. They will be cooking for their own meal as part of the training which will be monitored and supervised by the training staff.
5. All districts are encouraged to send 8 (composed of 4 boys and 4 seniors) of their **potential boy leaders to the venue and schedule where they belong or in which they are most comfortable. To maintain discipline in the camp, the ratio of 1 accompanying adult in every 4 scouts is encouraged. Service credits will be granted to teachers who will serve as training staff and chaperons provided they are also registered in the camp along with their scouts.** It is encouraged that accompanying adults must be at least a graduate of the Basic Training Course for Outfit Advisors/Troop Leaders and will be utilized as support staff during the training for them to be familiar with the skills and activities in scouting and also to maintain the security of the scouts on the duration of the training.


6. All delegates must assemble at the respective venue at 8:00 o'clock in the morning of the first day in Type A Uniform or at least with a scout neckerchief for registration, organization, camp set up and opening program and must bring the following since this will be a training-in-camp:


- Type A & B uniforms
- tent and sleeping gears
- mess kit and toiletries
- ropes for knot tying
- first aid kit
- Raincoat
- compass
- rubber shoes and slippers
- Notebook and ball pen
- extra shirts and underwear
- scout knife and flashlights (optional)
- cooking and kitchen utensils
