Event Rules and Mechanics <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Players should bring 2 pieces of stick which measures 1 foot (long stick) and ½ foot (short stick) with 1 inch in diameter. 2. The base player hurls the short stick off the furrow using the longer stick. 3. The base player hits the short stick which is in an inclined position in the furrow. If the base player misses to hit the short stick, the player will be given a second chance. Once the short stick is hit, the official counts the distance from the drop point to the furrow using the long stick. 4. If the base player hits the short stick twice before the dropping and the opponent misses to catch it, the official counts the distance using the short stick. 5. Finally, the players will be ranked according to their earned points.

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The committee will provide the thorns for the entire contest. Jumpers form a queue and the thorns take their position. 2. The thorns (A & B) sit, facing each other with the soles of their feet touching. The jumpers must successfully jump through without touching any of the thorns body parts. 3. The thorn's foot is used as base, then both thorn's (A & B) Feet and hand will be placed above the base alternately to create the next level. 4. Only successful jumpers can proceed to the next level. Unsuccessful jumper will step aside and wait until everyone has their turn jumping over the thorns. 5. All the unsuccessful ones will be given second chance. If he still remains unsuccessful, then he is out of the game. 6. If 2 or more jumpers successfully passed the levels of thorn A & B, then another thorn will be used until only one has successfully jumped all the horns.

Description	<p>Takyan (Cebuano word for Sipa meaning 'to kick') is a favorite traditional sport in the Philippines. Both boys and girls play this sport. A single person can play sipa by himself or herself, but there are moves to standardize the game with rules and teams.</p> <p>In formal games, a rattan ball is used, but when Filipino kids play at home or in schools they use either a big bunch of rubber bands knotted together or a small metal disk that has a fluffy tail of shredded plastic.</p> <p>Traditionally, boys kick in front of the body while girls modestly kick behind the body. Skillful players can kick it any number of ways. When played informally among friends, the game is to see who can kick the item the most consecutive number of times. Scoring	The shortest time consumed to complete the task ranks 1, the second shortest ranks 2, and so on.

Event Rules and Mechanics

1. Using the player's own takyan, he kicks it for 30 number of times without dropping it in a single play.
2. The player must be barefooted in playing this game. His foot has to touch the ground every after count.
3. Once the takyan drops the ground before reaching 30 hits, the number of hits the player made will be considered for the ranking.
4. Players are ranked according to the time consumed to complete.

Description	Palosebo is a traditional Filipino game. This game is usually played by boys during a town fiesta or on special occasions in the various provinces of the Philippines. Long and straight bamboo poles are polished and greased, after which a small bag containing the prize is tied to the top. The bag usually contains money, sweets, or toys. Sometimes a small flag is used instead of the actual prize, which is given to the winner afterwards.	
Criteria for Assessment	Criteria	Percentage
Event Rules and Mechanics:		
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. This competition is open to Grade 8 – 10 male students 2. The competition shall simultaneously use two (2) bamboo poles during the actual conduct thereof and which shall be prepared by the contest organizer 3. These bamboo poles shall be polished and applied with grease as obstacles of this game. Every after contestant who have finished climbing the bamboo, the bamboo shall be applied with grease / oil. 4. Order of contestants shall be dependent on the arrival of contestants who have underwent the preceding four (4) games 5. A height of 20 feet shall be the standard size of the material 6. Every contestant shall be allotted a maximum of three (3) minutes to play the game 7. Ranking of contestants shall be based on the time they have reached, holded and waved the flaglet placed in the topmost part of the bamboo pole. The shortest time shall be ranked on top against other opponents 8. Should there be contestants who will fail to reach, hold and wave the flaglet within three (3) minutes, their ranking shall be determined according to the height of the bamboo being labeled where they reached or touched 9. There shall be a board of judges who will make decisions relevant to the stipulated rules and mechanics. Their decisions are considered final and irrevocable.
