In line with the Council Training School for the fiscal year July 2018 - June 2019, Bohol Girl Scout Council will conduct the **Basic Course for CD 3** on **August 10-12, 2018** to be hosted by Valencia District at **Valencia Central Elementary School** in Poblacion Oriental, Valencia, Bohol.

The Basic Course provides basic knowledge about the aims, philosophies, policies, and programs of the Girl Scouts of the Philippines at all levels, as well as basic knowledge in organizing and managing a troop.

Registration Fee & Inclusions

One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P1,500.00) per participant to cover for meals, training materials and other training expenses.

Arrival and Departure

- Participants are expected to be at the venue on August 10 (Friday) at 4:00 in the afternoon until the last day on August 12 (Sunday) at 4:00 in the afternoon.
- The course is a live-in training, thus, all participants should stay at the venue for the whole duration.

Meals

First Meal is dinner on August 10, and last meal is P.M. Snacks on August 12.

Tentative Program Schedule

- Day 1, Friday
Afternoon & Evening - Arrival, Registration & Settling Down, and Orientation
- Day 2, Saturday
Morning - Opening Ceremony, and Sessions
Afternoon & Evening - Sessions, and Campfire
- Day 3, Sunday
Morning - Holy Mass, Scout's Own, and Sessions
Afternoon - Sessions, Evaluation, Closing Ceremony, and Departure

The registration fee, and transportation/travelling expenses of the participants are chargeable against Division/School Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE), District share of SMFC tickets, local and other sources of funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Compensatory Time Off (CTO) or Service Credit can be claimed for the extra service rendered on Saturday and Sunday.
