

2018 WORLD FOOD DAY DIVISION ON-THE-SPOT POSTER MAKING CONTEST

To : **PUBLIC AND PRIVATE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL HEADS

1. The Department of Agriculture (DA) and the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) of the United Nations, in partnership with Department of Education (Dep-Ed) will conduct the 2018 World Food Day Regional On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest on September 25, 2018 at Cebu Business Hotel, Colon Street, Cebu City with the theme "Our Action are our Future, A #Zero Hunger World by 2030 is possible".
2. The contest is open to all Grade IV to VI elementary pupils enrolled in any public and DepEd accredited private elementary schools. The top three (3) division winners are eligible to participate in the regional level competition and shall be provided the necessary materials needed at the venue during the said contest.
3. In view of this, the Division level competition is scheduled on September 19, 2018 at the City Division Conference Hall, Dampas District, Tagbilaran City, 8:30 in the morning. Contestants are advised to bring their own materials to be used in the contest. Please see the attached Contest Mechanics and the Criteria for Judging.

Contest Mechanics (Regional/National Level)

1. The contest is open to all Grades IV to VI elementary pupils enrolled in any public and DepEd-accredited private elementary schools nationwide. Previous national winners are disqualified to join at any level of this contest. The regional contest will be conducted from August and September 2018.
2. The poster making shall be an original creation of eligible participants, depicting the central theme of the World Food Day 2018 celebration, Our Actions are our Future. A #Zero Hunger World by 2030 is possible".
3. Criteria for judging:

a. Originality	-	20%
b. Creativity	-	20%
c. Visual Impact	-	20%
d. Relevance to the theme	-	40%
TOTAL		100%
4. Materials to be used such as illustration board (20"x 30"), oil pastel color and pentel pen will be provided by the Regional On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest Committee during the regional contest. A poster with no indicated theme shall be disqualified.
5. Theme should be hand written above and/or outside the art work and should take up no more than two and a half inches (2.5") for portrait and two inches (2") for landscape.
6. The poster making contest shall be conducted on-the-spot in the regional level. Winners and non-winners will receive cash and/or in-kind prizes.
7. Only one (1) regional winning poster shall be the official entry of the region during the national judging to be held at the DA-central Office on October 3, 2018 at DA-Central Office. All regional poster entries must be received by the National Secretariat of the Poster Making Contest Committee on or before October 1, 2018 at 5:00 p.m.
8. Description of the poster entry must be written at the back of the poster with the name of the pupil, name of the school and region.
