TINY TRASH ACTUAL SIZE

The ocean is our source of food, livelihood, new medicines and enjoyment. Trash in the ocean causes pollution, entanglement of turtles, marine mammals, & sea birds and impairment of water vessels. Picking up trash on beaches, rivers and waterways is one way of bringing back the health of the ocean. If you like to join a cleanup on International Coastal Cleanup (ICC) Day, here are the basic things you need to know.

When is ICC Day and How to Join

ICC Day is held every year on the 3rd Saturday of September. Individuals, group leaders or organizations must SIGNUP / REGISTER with the PCGA or ICC Philippines by email or website. You may also contact local ICC Coordinators listed at the website.

Where is your cleanup site?

Ask from city/municipal government offices (PENRO, CENRO), Philippine Coast Guard, Philippine Coast Guard Auxiliary schools, NGOs or any organizations who will join the cleanup. Visit the websites for probable cleanup sites.



What is Data Recording and its Importance

During ICC, we not only pick up trash/marine debris but also record and tally the kind of trash collected in an Ocean Trash Data Form. Data collected will be useful in updating ordinances and programs on waste management, in making eco-friendly product and packaging innovations and in raising environmental awareness.



Where can you get ICC materials?

Ocean Trash Data Forms, slide presentations for orientation, brochures, templates for ICC banner/tarpaulin, certificate and T-shirt and other materials are available for downloading at the website. Email ICC Philippines for requests.

How Do You Organize A Cleanup?

Build your group of volunteers. Conduct ICC orientation meetings. For Site/Area Coordinators, identify & assess your cleanup site. Ask local officials for permission to access the cleanup site. Look for Sponsors to support your activities. Ask the local government for help on garbage truck, water equipment and manpower. Reproduce the Data Form for distribution on ICC Day. Prepare a plan with timeline for your pre and post ICC activities.



Safety on ICC Day

Safety is always a priority. Wear gloves or use tongs/sticks when picking up sharp, pointed objects and personal hygiene debris type. Children must be supervised at all times. Check weather and tide levels before ICC Day. If weather is bad, cancellation and rescheduling of ICC will be recommended by the Site Coordinator.

Post Cleanup Activities

Check your Ocean Trash Data Form before submission. Use numbers to tally total debris items. Make proper estimations (i.e. 1 sack=7 kilos). After filling-up all required information, **SUBMIT IMMEDIATELY** the Coordinator on site or to ICC Philippines by email or website.

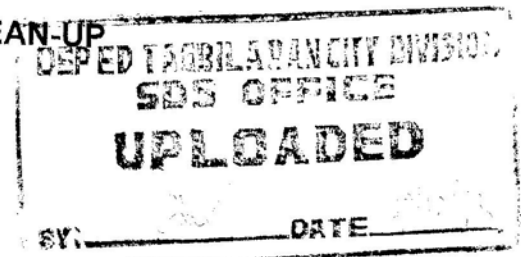
