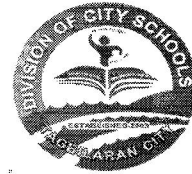

**Value Formation and Leadership Training**

2. VFLT Program has the following objectives:

  - c. To enlighten hearts and minds through values impartation.
  - d. To promote progressive change through values adoption.
