**SPOKEN POETRY**

**Guidelines:**

**THEME: "RCY AMPLIFY: Advancing the Mission as People's Lifeline Imbued by the Filipino Youth"**

SPOKEN POETRY is a performance art that is word based. It is a writing that is meant to be spoken or delivered with emotions to an audience. It is an oral art that focuses on the aesthetics of wordplay, rhythm, improvisation, rhymes, intonation and voice inflection.

**I. REGISTRATION AND ELIGIBILITY**

1. The Philippine Red Cross Bohol Chapter- Red Cross Youth Spoken Poetry Competition is open to all RCY Councils in the province of Bohol. One participant each council and must be a member of MAAB (Membership Fund with Accident Assistance Benefits).
2. Interested councils must pre-register their participation in a registration form given by the organizing team. There is no registration fee.
3. The deadline of the submission of the registration form will be on October 5, 2018 at the Philippine Red Cross Bohol Chapter- Red Cross Youth Office or email us at [rcy@redcross.org.ph](mailto:rcy@redcross.org.ph).

**II. SPOKEN POETRY COMPETITION PROPER**

10. The 8 participants will be invited to Island City Mall Activity Center for the Spoken Poetry Competition which will be held on October 13, 2018.
11. The participant is required to wear any Red Cross Shirt.
12. Participant is given a maximum of 5-6 minutes to present his/her poetry. The additional time is a deduction to the overall rating.
13. The spoken poetry must be an original composition which contains messages related to the theme and not copied from any source.
14. Three printed copies must be provided to be given to the organizer of the contest one hour before the contest proper.
15. Sounds, instrumental or musical background are allowed to complement the delivery. No deduction shall be made if the contestant opts not to have a musical background.

**III. AWARDS**

1. First Prize - Medal and Certificate of Recognition
2. Second Prize - Medal and Certificate of Recognition
3. Third Prize - Medal and Certificate of Recognition

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8. Interested participant, upon completion of requirements, qualifies for the painting contest. This will be on a first-come, firstserve basis and is open up until **8 participants ONLY**.

**VI. JUDGING OF WINNERS**

1. The chosen experts in poetry and speaking together with representatives from the major sponsors will be the members of the Board of Judges.
2. Criteria of judging will be based on:
  - a. **Message/ Content- 40%**
    - The content of the spoken piece is relevant and related to the theme.
    - The piece has a powerful and meaningful message to the audience.
  - b. **Delivery and Performance- 30%**
    - The spoken piece was delivered from the heart.
    - Facial expressions, hand and body gestures emphasized the different elements of the performance.
    - Eye contact pulled the audience to the message of the spoken words.
    - Audience's attention and interest were captured and sustained throughout the delivery.
    - Enunciation is clear. Audience can understand what is being spoken.
    - Words are pronounced distinctly and correctly. Does not stutter nor stammer.
  - c. **Voice Variation and Projection- 20%**
    - Voice is modulated, compelling and phrasing is fluent.
    - Speak loudly and clearly, enough for listeners to hear and understand.
    - Voice projects confidence and conviction.
  - d. **Memorization 10%**
    - The piece was effectively recited from memory.
    - Freestyle or improvisation was spontaneous even if a word or line was forgotten

Total Rating: 100%

**VII. GENERAL GUIDELINES**

1. The literary piece must be an original work that is wholly conceptualized and composed by the participant. Composition which copied the content of existing works will automatically be disqualified, even if they are rendered in a different style.
2. Major winners give PRC Bohol Chapter RCY the authority to use their performances in publication, promotional use and other purposes deemed necessary with proper and due acknowledgment and recognition of the participant.
3. RCY organization reserves the right to withdraw any award at any time should the participant violate any of the rules and regulations of the contest or if the RCY organization deems, in any way, that granting the participant the award will damage the reputation of the organization.
4. Failure to comply with the above rules and regulations shall automatically disqualify the participant/s.
5. By submitting the signed entry form, participant agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of the contest.

7. The scoring for each corresponding category are the following:
  - a. Easy Round- each question is worth 5 points      Total Score: 25 pts
  - b. Average Round- each question is worth 10 points      Total Score: 50 pts
  - c. Difficult Round- each question is worth 15 points.      Total Score: 75 ptsOverall Perfect Score: 150 pts
8. Time Allotment:
  - a. Easy Round- 20 seconds/question
  - b. Average Round- 25 seconds/question
  - c. Difficult Round- 30 seconds/question
9. The contestant will be given the materials needed for answering such as boards, chalk or marker and eraser.
10. Before the quiz master will start, the contestants are ask to raise their chalk or marker then as the quiz master is done reading the question, the contestant will start writing as the quiz master will say "GO!".
11. The contestant will then raise their boards as they hear the bell rings which signify that the time is up.
12. The assigned organizer will count the correct answers and tally it in the board or excel prepared. He/she will also be the one to monitor the total score of each category.
13. Cheating is greatly prohibited. Once caught will be disqualified.
14. Wrong spelling is wrong.
15. In case of tie scores, another round will be added to the two contestants to break it. The time and corresponding score will depend on the quiz master. The quiz master will announce the ruling of the tiebreaker round before the quiz starts.
16. As the total scores are computed, the first 3 winners will be announced.
17. The proper awarding and giving of certificates of recognition will be during the RCY program.



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18. Participants will be given a total of 5 hours to complete the painting. The artwork must be done within the allotted time.
19. The participants will provide the canvas, basic acrylic paint colors, paint brushes, palette and other materials they will going to use for their artwork.
20. Participants who wish to use additional medium may do so, provided that they are responsible to bring such media/materials.
21. The painting contest will take place on an open space and participants may bring their own table mount/stand.
22. The paintings should be given a title and a short description to be written in the form.
23. If the participant comes late, he/she may still be accommodated but will not be given time extension.
24. Schedule:
  - a. Registration – 12:00-1:00 pm
  - b. Contest Duration – 1:00-5:00 pm
  - c. Judging – 5:00-6:00 pm
  - d. Awarding – RCY Program

**VI JUDGING OF WINNERS**

1. The chosen experts in the field of mixed media together with representatives from the major sponsors will be the members of the Board of Judges.
2. Criteria of judging will be based on:
  - a. Interpretation and the clarity of the theme to the viewer -30% ;
  - b. Creativity and originality of the depicted theme- 20% ;
  - c. Quality of the artistic composition and overall design-20% ;
  - d. Overall Impression of the art- 30%**Total Rating= 100%**

**VII GENERAL GUIDELINES**

1. The artwork must be an original work that is wholly conceptualized and executed by the participant. Designs which copied the composition of existing works will automatically be disqualified, even if they are rendered in a different style, medium, color scheme, or even if other elements have been added.
2. Art craft of the major winners will be surrendered to Red Cross Youth Services office. The paintings will be displayed in Philippine Red Cross-Bohol Chapter.
3. Major winners give RCY organization the authority to use the paintings for general publication, promotional use and other purposes deemed necessary with proper and due acknowledgment and recognition of the painters.
4. The RCY organization reserves the right to withdraw any award at any time should the participant violate any of the rules and regulations of the contest or if RCY deems, in any way, that granting the participant the award will damage the reputation of the organization.
5. Failure to comply with the above rules and regulations shall automatically disqualify the participant/s.
6. By submitting the signed entry form, participant agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of the contest.



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## **GUKOD TA BAI!**

Like other youth organizations, Red Cross Youth uses team building activities as "skill and value formation" to its youth members. Nevertheless, RCY has a different strategy or style on giving challenges during team-building activities so-called "The Red Cross Way". During RCY trainings and social gatherings, the teambuilding activity is the most-awaited part, given that it's unique not only on the challenges themselves but also on the relevance of values and skill development in line with the works and efforts of the premiere humanitarian organization. On RCY Summercamps, Team-building outdoor activity is commonly known as "The Amazing Solferino Race", depicting the "The Battle of Solferino" that happened at Solferino, Italy on the year 1859 wherein the idea of the Red Cross was born.

Last year, "Gukod" was organized as one of the activities of Bohol Red Cross Youth Days 2017. It was a 1-day activity of intense and extreme challenges situated on the different parts of Tagbilaran City.

This Bohol Red Cross Youth Days 2018, Red Cross Youth Bohol will once again hold the grandest and biggest event of challenges to our youth volunteers: "**Gukod ta Bai**". This time, the intensity of challenges will be doubled. The activity is open to all RCY Volunteers from different Senior, Senior Plus, College, and Community RCY Councils.

The activity also includes "mini-games" open to the youth, advocacy booths on Leadership, Pledge25 Youth Blood Donation, HAPE/SAPE, First Aid, other health promotions, and Membership Fund Drive.

**Date:** October 28, 2018

**Program Venue:** Plaza Rizal Grounds

**Event Vicinity:** Certain parts of Tagbilaran City. (Stations to be announced further)

### **Guidelines:**

1. Gukod ta Bai! is open to all RCY Councils in the province of Bohol.
2. Interested councils must submit the registration form given by the organizing team and must be submitted on or before October 5, 2018 06:00PM – Friday, at the Philippine Red Cross Bohol Chapter, Red Cross Youth Office or email us at [redcrossyouthbohol@gmail.com](mailto:redcrossyouthbohol@gmail.com)
3. A council can send only one entry composed of 6 members per entry. *Note: At least (3) members of the entry must be RCY Volunteers.*
4. Everybody must be physically fit to join the race. Medical Certificates of its participating members must be submitted by the council within the week before the activity.
5. Gukod ta Bai is composed of challenges that are situated on the different parts of Tagbilaran City.
6. The race will be on October 28, 2018, Sunday. Other information will be announced on October 20, 2018, after The Exposition.
7. The racers must arrive at the venue 30 minutes before the start of the race. Failure to do so will mean automatic disqualification.
8. The number of stations and procedure of challenges will be announced on the day of GukodNapud.

Participating in the Search for Miss Red Cross Youth Bohol not only provides a male youth volunteer an opportunity to gain additional life experiences, but also to bring awareness to important humanitarian issues in the Philippines especially in Bohol. Contestants can enhance their personal and professional skills while developing their performance-related talents.

The Search for Miss Red Cross Youth Bohol is more than a mere attractiveness and intellect contest for the youth; it is a pageant that ponders all aspects of their appearances and characters. Its mission is to crown stunning youth volunteers with love, passion, and advocacy for humanity. The crowned winner will represent and advocate for Red Cross Youth Bohol. He will be entitled as Red Cross Youth Bohol Ambassador during her reign. Finalists will also have chances to participate in various events, work with various humanitarian causes and make lifetime memories.

**The pageant will be held on October 27, 2018 at the Activity Centre of Island City Mall, Tagbilaran City.**

**MISS RED CROSS YOUTH BOHOL 2018**

**A. QUALIFICATIONS**

Senior, College, and Community Red Cross Youth Councils in Bohol are encouraged to endorse one (1) male candidate per council for **Miss Red Cross Youth Bohol 2018** title. She:

- Must be a bona fide Red Cross Youth Volunteer of any Council in Bohol;
- Must be legally single without children;
- Must be at least 16 years old and not more than 20 years old this year;
- Must submit a signed parent's/guardian's waiver for all;
- Must have never won any major title in any municipal, city-wide, provincial, regional, national, or international pageants;
- Will have to secure a written endorsement from her respective RCY Adviser and school/institution Head;
- Must submit all necessary forms (Endorsement, Personal Data) for the pageant on or before October 01, 2018;
- Must be able to attend all scheduled activities and rehearsals;
- Must avail the P60.00 Classic Membership if still not a member of PRC.

**Note:** The Presidents of the RCY Councils are not qualified to join. They have separate responsibilities as per order by the Chapter Youth Council.



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**B. MECHANICS**

Candidates will be required to prepare for and participate in the following parts of the pageant:

**PART 1 (Pre-Pageant)**

**I. Panel Interview**

- Candidates will be interviewed by a panel composed of three (3) interviewers within ten (10) minutes.
- Required Attire: Casual wear, Red Cross Youth Council Uniform.
- Date and place of the interview will be announced upon submission of endorsement and other forms.

**II. Photo-shoot**

- Candidates must free their schedule for one (1) day for the Photo-shoot.
- Required Attire: Red Cross Youth Type B Uniform.
- Date, time, and place for Photo-shoot will be announced upon submission of endorsement and other forms.
- Photographer's choice of candidate will receive the Miss Photogenic Award. (Set of Criteria will be given to the photographer as guide)

**III. Support Boxes**

- The RCY councils of the candidates will be given Support Boxes, one (1) per council, during the opening or start of the Gukod activity.
- The boxes are to be surrendered on the day of the pageant at 10:00 am to the authorized officers. If the submission of the Support Box is late, 20% of the total amount will be deducted.
- Support boxes are coin banks with pictures of the candidates. Everyone can give a vote to their candidate by donating any amount in her support box.
- The counting of money will be documented and must be witnessed by one (1) representative from the Chapter Youth Council, one (1) representative from the Council of Presidents, and one (1) representative from the League of Advisers.
- The Candidates with the most no. of votes will receive the **People's Choice Award** and will become part of the Top 5 Finalists. (If the candidates with the most no. of votes is already part of the Top 5, the second with the most no. of votes will have the chance.) **Every Php 20.00 is equivalent to 1 vote.**

**IV. Social Media's Choice**

- After the photo-shoot, the photos of the candidates will be uploaded on the Official Facebook Page of the Red Cross Youth Bohol (fb.com/RCYouthBohol)
- Everyone can give one vote to their candidate by reacting **WOW** in her official pageant photo.
- The voting will close 12 hours before the pageant proper.



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- The checking of votes will be documented and must be witnessed by one (1) representative from the Chapter Youth Council, one (1) representative from the Council of Presidents, and one (1) representative from the League of Advisers.
- The Candidate with the most wow reactions will receive the **Social Media's Choice Award**.

**PART 2 (Pageant-First Round)**

**I. Production Number**

- The attire will be finalized during the rehearsals.

**II. Talent Portion**

- Performance must be a maximum of three (3) minutes only. Timer starts with the first sound, or action in the talent. A timer will signal the end of the time duration. If the candidate extends her performance five (5) seconds or more after the signal, 3 points will be deducted from the average score.
- Back-up performers are allowed if and only they are 15 years old and above. (Performers below 15 years old must give a waiver signed by their parent/guardian as implementation of the Child Protection Policy of the Philippine Red Cross.)
- Props and supporting accompaniments may be used. The set-up and set-down of things must be within 1 minute each. There will be a deduction of .10 points of the candidate if there will be an extension of the set-up and set-down.
- Fire, water, weapons, and other dangerous, harmful, and explicitly offending objects, and even confetti are not allowed to be used as props.
- Talent performances must value the Principles of the Red Cross Movement. It means that it must be within the limit of moral decency and must not offend anyone's sensibilities.
- All technical means must be submitted or tested on October 26, 2018.

**III. Filipiniana Wear**

- In RCY Bohol, formal wears go beyond expectations. A candidate will present her artistic piece of Filipiniana Wear that must be originally created by her co-volunteers using recyclable and eco-friendly materials. The said candidate must reflect with the motif: "**Boholano Culture**"
- This is the chance to prove the creativity of the RCY Volunteers of the council.
- Make sure that the candidate can still move and walk comfortably with her outfit.
- Candidates will be judged according with the given criteria. Whoever gets the highest score will receive the Best in Filipiniana Wear Award.

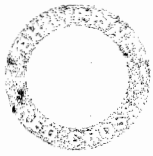
