It encourages young people, ages 11-13, to think about peace, creatively express what it means to them and to share their own unique visions with the world. Contestants are asked to create a poster that visually communicates the contest theme, "KINDNESS MATTERS." This opens up an opportunity for parents, teachers and group leaders to discuss with children the true importance of peace.

In connection to the above club activity, I would like to ask your kind consent/permission to participate in this contest by sending at least two contestants (aged 11-13) from every public and private elementary schools in our City Of Tagbilaran. Contestants are requested to bring their own media (crayon/pastels/chalk/charcoal). The cartolina will be provided by the club. The contest will start at 8am until 12NN and snacks will be provided to the contestants.

Three winners will be selected by the Judges and prizes will be awarded to the top three. The best poster will advance to face stiff competition through the district, multiple district and international rounds of competition if (he/she) is to be declared the international grand prize winner. One grand prize winner and 23 merit award winners will be selected. The grand prize includes a cash award of US\$5,000.00, plus a trip for the winner and two family members to the awards ceremony at Lions Day with the United Nations. The 23 merit award winners will each receive a certificate and a cash award of US\$500.00.
