In December 2017, the 13th Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City Government of Tagbilaran approved the "Comprehensive Smoke-Free Ordinance of the City Government of Tagbilaran" which imposes strict penalty to individuals who would smoke in public places and openly promote tobacco products. This is pursuant to Executive Order No. 26 signed by President Rodrigo R. Duterte on May 17, 2017 banning smoking in public places nationwide.

After months of planning, the city's smoke-free task force committee decided to formally launch the massive campaign against smoking and tobacco products, via activities slated for October 9, 2018 (Tuesday) at the CPG Sports Complex.

The City Government of Tagbilaran, through the City Health Office, is spearheading the event that will kick off with a multi-sectoral parade start at 6:00 A.M. Please refer to the attached route of the parade, for your information and guidance.

In this regard, we wish to invite the elementary (grade 5 and up) and secondary schools of the Tagbilaran City Schools Division to join in the said activity by sending at least 100 participants per school composed of teacher and students, if possible, wearing uniform T-shirts for easy identification and bringing with them their own contingent banners, and placards reflecting antismoking slogans, quotations, and messages. We are attaching the mechanics and criteria for those who are interested to join in the slogan contest.

With this, we enjoin your active participation that will manifest your support for our staunch campaign for a smoke-free community.

- 1. The contest is open to all elementary (grade 5 to grade 6), high-school and college students enrolled in any Tagbilaran City schools, whether public or private.
- 2. Each participant should submit one (1) entry only.
- 3. During the contest proper, the students should bring the following:
 - a. Half-white cartolina
 - b. Coloring materials
- 4. The slogan must emphasize and reinforce the theme of the **Anti-Smoking Campaign** in the City: "(Put theme here)"
- 5. The participants will be held accountable to any issues that may arise with regards to the originality and authenticity of the slogan. The winners' output will be exhibited at the Tagbilaran City Hall Atrium.
- 6. The slogans will be judged according to the following criteria:

a.	Relevance to the theme	-		40%
b.	Creativity	-		30%
c.	Originality	-		10%
d.	Visual impact	-		20%

- 7. There will be three (3) winners for the contest -2^{nd} runner-up, 1^{st} runner-up, and Grand Champion
- 8. All the participating students will receive a Certificate of Participation. While the winners will receive Cash Prizes and a Certificate of Recognition.
