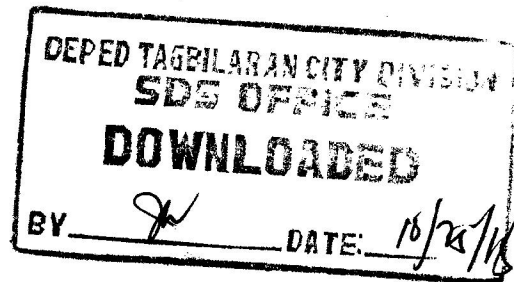

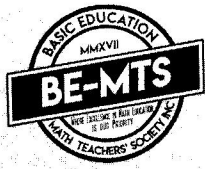

Venue: University of San Carlos, Cebu City, Philippines

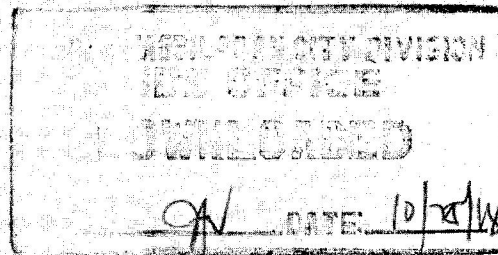
Theme: "Meeting the Challenging Needs of Millennial in Mathematics Education".

There were eight (8) plenary speakers: three (3) from Malaysia, two (2) from Vietnam, one (1) from Japan, one (1) South Africa, and one (1) from Philippines

Conference Activities:

- 1) Plenary Sessions
- 2) Research Paper Presentation (*Parallel Sessions - Type A*)
- 3) Demo-Teaching (*Parallel Sessions - Type B*)
- 4) Poster Presentations
- 5) Workshops in Mathematics Teaching-Learning
- 6) Math Calcu-lympics



Plenary Sessions include keynotes, invited papers on technologies in mathematics classrooms, and pedagogy for the 21st century mathematics learners. Invited experts come from renowned Universities here and abroad. *Time Frame: 50 minutes per session, 10 minutes open forum.*

Paper Presentation is a parallel session on research papers with the following topics, but not limited to: mathematics education, Statistics and applied mathematics, technology in mathematics classroom, and mathematics teaching-learning techniques and strategies. *Time Frame: 15 minutes presentation, 5 minutes open forum.*

Demo-Teaching is a parallel session on demo-teaching which highlights one's best/favorite practices. The teacher presenter serves as the classroom teacher and the audience acts as the students. *Time Frame: 50 minutes demo-teaching, 10 minutes open forum.*

Poster Presentation includes presentation of papers through a poster platform. The topics of the poster presentations include mathematics education or any of the topics mentioned above. *Time Frame: the entire conference days.*

Workshops in Mathematics Teaching-Learning include the following, but not limited to: use of emerging technologies in mathematics classroom, designing performance tasks, classroom teaching strategies, and developing instructional materials. *Time Frame: 1 hour per workshop.*

Math Calcu-lympics is a quiz bowl for mathematics teachers with the use of scientific calculators. Participants will receive Certificate of Participation. Cash prizes will given to the top 3 winners

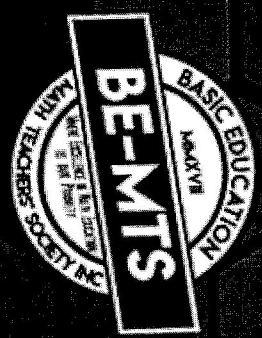
