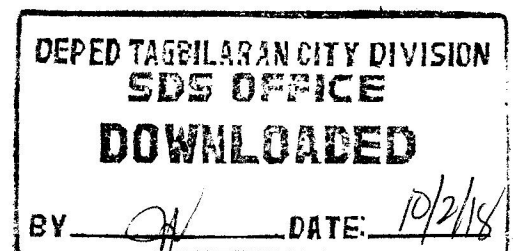

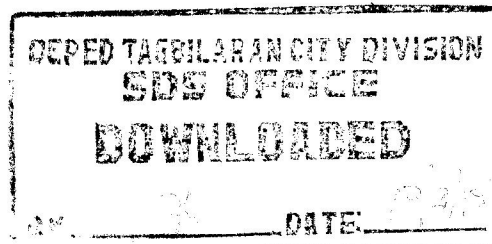

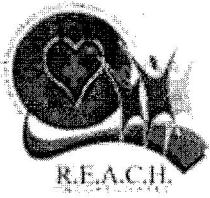

One important component of sensory processing is <i>sensory modulation</i>, which is the ability to respond appropriately to incoming sensory information. While this can be a stand-alone disorder in some individuals, we commonly see modulation issues overlap with ASD, ADHD, LD, and SPD. The use of a sensory diet is a research-based method of providing these individuals with the sensory input they need to function their best. This practical and evidence-based seminar will equip therapists (beginning to intermediate level), teachers, and caregivers with the ability to determine the sensory needs of the child and implement a sensory diet to meet the child's needs effectively.</p> <p>Objectives: At the end of the training, participants will:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.
