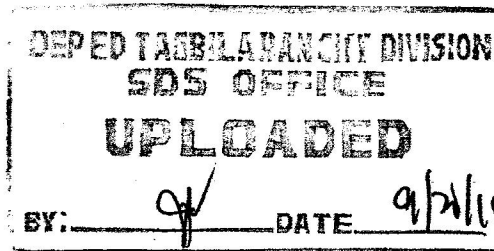

To coincide with the Values Education Month celebration, the Department of Education welcomes Philippines Sunbeam Missions of Hope (PSMH) National Youth Outreach headed by Ma'am Archil Daugherty of Oklahoma City, USA to conduct a 48 hour Value Formation and Leadership Training (VFLT) youth camp at Dr. Cecilio Putong National High School (DCPNHS) on November 30-December 2, 2018.
2. VFLT Program has the following objectives:
 - a. To reinforce classroom values education and instruction.
 - b. To teach values in a lively manner using the seven awe-inspiring colors of the rainbow.
 - c. To enlighten hearts and minds through values impartation.
 - d. To promote progressive change through values adoption.
