SUBJECT: CONDUCT OF REGULAR CITYWIDE INTENSIVE CLEAN-UP IN VIEW OF THE PROLIFERATION OF DENGUE CASES

Nearly 75% of all dengue cases worldwide occur in Asia and the Pacific, hence, the need to eradicate or limit the same is imperative.

Unfortunately, there is no specific treatment for dengue; early clinical diagnosis and appropriate clinical management of severe complications of the disease are key to increasing the survival of patients. It cannot be prevented by medicines or health care workers. Surveillance, timely reporting of cases, and proactive vector control are therefore necessary for dengue prevention.

In view of the foregoing and due to the escalating number of dengue cases in the City of Tagbilaran, all concerned are hereby directed to conduct regular citywide intensive clean-up drives, aside from vector surveillance and control, and resource mobilization involving other sectors in the community. You may also coordinate with the barangay councils and health centers for dengue-related activities.
