1. The Metrobank Foundation, Inc. (MBFI), the Mathematics Teachers Association of the Philippines (MTAP) and the Department of Education (DepEd) will hold the **2019 Metrobank-MTAP-DepEd Math Challenge (MMC)** from December 2018 to March 2019.

3. The Division Elimination competition will be participated in by elementary and junior high school students from public and private schools nationwide who were able to register online and submit the **MMC Form 1** via **<https://onlineportal.metrobankmathchallenge.com>**.
