ORIENTATION ON THE TECHNOLOGY SUPPORTED TEACHER PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT IN EARLY LANGUAGE, LITERACY, AND NUMERACY FOR K-3 TEACHERS (ELLN DIGITAL)

- 1. This Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), will conduct an Orientation on the **Technology Supported Teacher Professional Development in Early Language, Literacy, and Numeracy for K-3 Teachers (ELLN Digital)** on January 21, 2019 (Monday), (1:00 PM 5:00 PM) at the Division Office Conference Hall, Dampas, Tagbilaran City.
- 2. The ELLN Digital is a blended course on early language, literacy, and numeracy instruction for Kindergarten to Grade 3 (K-3) teachers in the Philippines. The course is a teacher professional development (TPD) initiative in support of the Department of Education's Early Language, Literacy, and Numeracy (ELLN) program under the Every Child a Reader Program (ECARP).
- 3. The course has two main **components**:
 - a) Self-study of an interactive multimedia courseware and
 - b) Collaborative learning in school-based Learning Action Cells (LACs)
- 4. After completing the course, the K-3 teacher is able to:
 - a) explain the principles of early language, literacy, and numeracy development and instruction,
 - b) discuss the components of balanced literacy and numeracy instruction, and
 - c) plan and implement balanced literacy and numeracy instruction for K-3 learners.
- 5. Participants to the said orientation are Education Program Supervisors, Division Coordinators, Public Schools District Supervisor and Public Elementary School Heads.
- 6. Travel expenses of participants are chargeable against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 7. Immediate dissemination of, and compliance with this Memorandum is directed.
