ORIENTATION ON THE TECHNOLOGY SUPPORTED TEACHER PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT IN EARLY LANGUAGE, LITERACY, AND NUMERACY FOR K-3 TEACHERS (ELLN DIGITAL)

1. This Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), will conduct an Orientation on the **Technology Supported Teacher Professional Development in Early Language, Literacy, and Numeracy for K-3 Teachers (ELLN Digital)** on January 21, 2019 (Monday), (1:00 PM – 5:00 PM) at the Division Office Conference Hall, Dampas, Tagbilaran City.
2. The ELLN Digital is a blended course on early language, literacy, and numeracy instruction for Kindergarten to Grade 3 (K-3) teachers in the Philippines. The course is a teacher professional development (TPD) initiative in support of the Department of Education's Early Language, Literacy, and Numeracy (ELLN) program under the Every Child a Reader Program (ECARP).
3. The course has two main components:
 - a) Self-study of an **interactive multimedia** courseware and
 - b) **Collaborative learning in school-based** Learning Action Cells (LACs)
4. After completing the course, the K-3 teacher is able to:
 - a) **explain the principles of early language, literacy, and numeracy development and instruction,**
 - b) **discuss the components of balanced literacy and numeracy instruction, and**
 - c) **plan and implement balanced literacy and numeracy instruction for K-3 learners.**
5. **Participants to the said orientation** are Education Program Supervisors, Division Coordinators, **Public Schools District Supervisor** and Public Elementary School Heads.
6. **Travel expenses** of participants are chargeable against local funds, subject to the usual **accounting and auditing rules and regulations.**
7. **Immediate dissemination of, and compliance with this Memorandum is directed.**
