Values Formation and Leadership Training

1). To continue and sustain the momentum we have started as we launched our values formation and leadership training last March 2018 at Manga National High School, the Department of Education welcomes SEC registered Sunbeam Global Values Formation and Leadership Training Incorporated headed by Ma'am Archil Daugherty of Oklahoma City, USA to conduct a series of school based Level 1 youth camps as follows:

- a.) February 22-24, 2019 at Manga National High School
- b.) March 8-10, 2019 at San Isidro National High School
- c.) March 22-24, 2019 at Mansasa National High School
- d.) April 5-7, 2019 at Tagbilaran City Science High School
- e.) April 12-14, 2019 at Cogon National High School
- f.) May 9-11, 2019 at DCPNHS for the Level 1 trained Teen Facilitators from all six secondary schools for their advanced Training for the Level 2 youth camp dubbed **YOU RAISE ME UP TO BE A RIGHTEOUS LEADER**

2). It is advised that school heads concerned will assign a lead EsP teacher to enlist student campers who will join the school based encampment, oversee the use of school facilities, assign classrooms as sleeping quarters for the student campers and Sunbeam Global VFLTI Staff, ensure that every camper has a signed parents permit/consent form, and designate into groups all student campers using the 7 colors of the rainbow.

3. All EsP teachers are given service credits as they assist in our school-based value formation and leadership training youth camp since you are already familiar with its activities having attended our EsP Teachers Reorientation on Essential Values held last November 26-27, 2018 at Gardenville Food and Events Center in Dampas should the schedule falls on a weekend. All ESP teachers are requested to help.

4). It is further advised that school heads assign teacher chaperones to accompany students in their sleeping quarters for two nights as well as delegate teachers who will do the budgeting, marketing, and meal preparation for our student campers. Furthermore, school heads are reminded to involve the PTA and give Ma'am Archil Daugherty time to explain to the parents what the youth camp is all about. We must recognize the important role of the PTA in this program.

5). The VFLT Program has the following objectives:

- a.) To reinforce classroom values education and instruction.
- b.) To teach values in a lively manner using the 7 magnificent colors of the rainbow.
- c.) To enlighten hearts and minds through values impartation.
- d.) To promote progressive change through values adoption.
- e.) To create peace-loving and positive minded families; united and well educated communities; a financially stable economy; and a debt-free country through values application.

6). Further, it is advised that classes will not be disrupted and attendance of students to such activity will be on a voluntary basis and with parents' permission.

7). Our school-based VFLT youth camp is a joint undertaking between DepEd and Philippines Sunbeam Global VFLT Inc. to promote and speed up the Moral Recovery Program of the Philippine Government. (See Attached letter from the Office of the President of the Philippines)
