

POPCOM employs a holistic approach for AHDP. The **program design** does not only focus on enhancing the knowledge and skills of the adolescent but it also builds **on the capacity** of parents and teachers in handling issues and concerns related to adolescence.

Another trailblazing project of POPCOM VII which is **on its fifth** year of implementation is the AHDP Integration Workshop. This initiative is in **coordination with DepEd Region VII**.
