Subject: Cornerstone Program Implementation for SY 2019-2020

1. In partnership with Ateneo Center for Educational Development. (ACED), Couples for Christ – Bohol Global Mission Foundation, Inc. (CFC) and DepEd – Divisions of Bohol and Tagbilaran City in helping public basic education in the country will continue to implement “Cornerstone Program” for SY 2019-2020 that seek to equip children, youth and adults in the school community with the human and social, moral, spiritual and professional aspects of development. Moreover, skills will be provided in order to improve student performance and enable participation to become productive members of society.
2. The Cornerstone Program has four components to wit: 1.) The Elementary Program aims to reach out to show readers in public schools through reading tutorials and orient their values through formation sessions. 2.) The Highschool program aims to reach out to Highschool students through leadership and values formation. 3.) Family support is provided through parenting formation and 4.) Child sponsorships will be given to gifted students in the public schools.
3. As a matter of support, this Office hereby endorsed the program to the schools indicated above. Service credits shall be given to teachers who will be assigned as Cornerstone School Moderator/ Teacher adviser and volunteers of the program.
4. A re-orientation activity to be attended by the School Head/ Principals and School Moderators of the above-mentioned schools will be conducted on Friday, June 28, 2019 from 8:30AM to 4:00PM at BPSTEMPC building, Tamblot St., Tagbilaran City.
5. Cornerstone School Moderators are instructed to bring the new list of pupil/ student beneficiaries and other required year-end and initial reports during the orientation activity.
6. Meal and snacks shall be provided by CFC-Bohol or ANCOP (Answering the Cry of the Poor) funds.
7. Travel expenses incurred in attending this activity shall be charged to School MOOE and other funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules of the COA.
