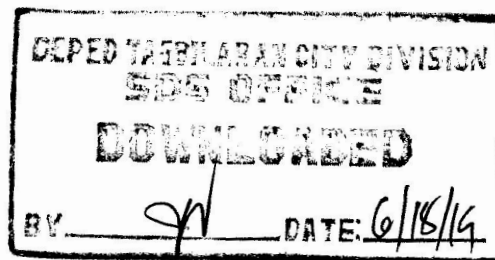


The objectives of the films are the following:
