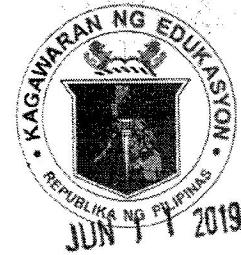

3. In this connection, all SDOs shall submit copies of their developed IPlans which were reviewed by the subject area specialist and quality-assured by the Learning Resource Supervisor. Hard and soft copies of the developed, piloted and validated IPlans during the Systematic Instructional Planning Program (SIPP) under the Basic Education Sector Transformation (BEST) are already ready for distribution.
