DENGUE AWARENESS CAMPAIGN

To: Public and Private Elementary and Secondary School Heads
All Others Concerned

1. Dengue is considered by the Department of Health as an all-year round disease which rises in incidence during the rainy season due to presence of more breeding places for disease-causing aedes aegypti type of mosquitoes, being the case, all stakeholders are reminded of its continuing threat not just in the community but also in the schools.

2. The month of June is dubbed as "National Dengue Awareness Month" by virtue of Proclamation No. 1204 on April 21, 1998 by then President Fidel V. Ramos.

3. In support of the Department of Health's campaign against dengue, schools should maintain the cleanliness and sanitation in their campus. Removed all possible breeding sites like used tires, tin cans, coconut shells, empty bottles, roof gutters, and even flower vases, uninhabited fish ponds, rain catchments, bromeliad plants, discarded plastics cups, cellophane bags, bottle cap, open drainage system and any other objects which when uncovered can collect and hold water.
